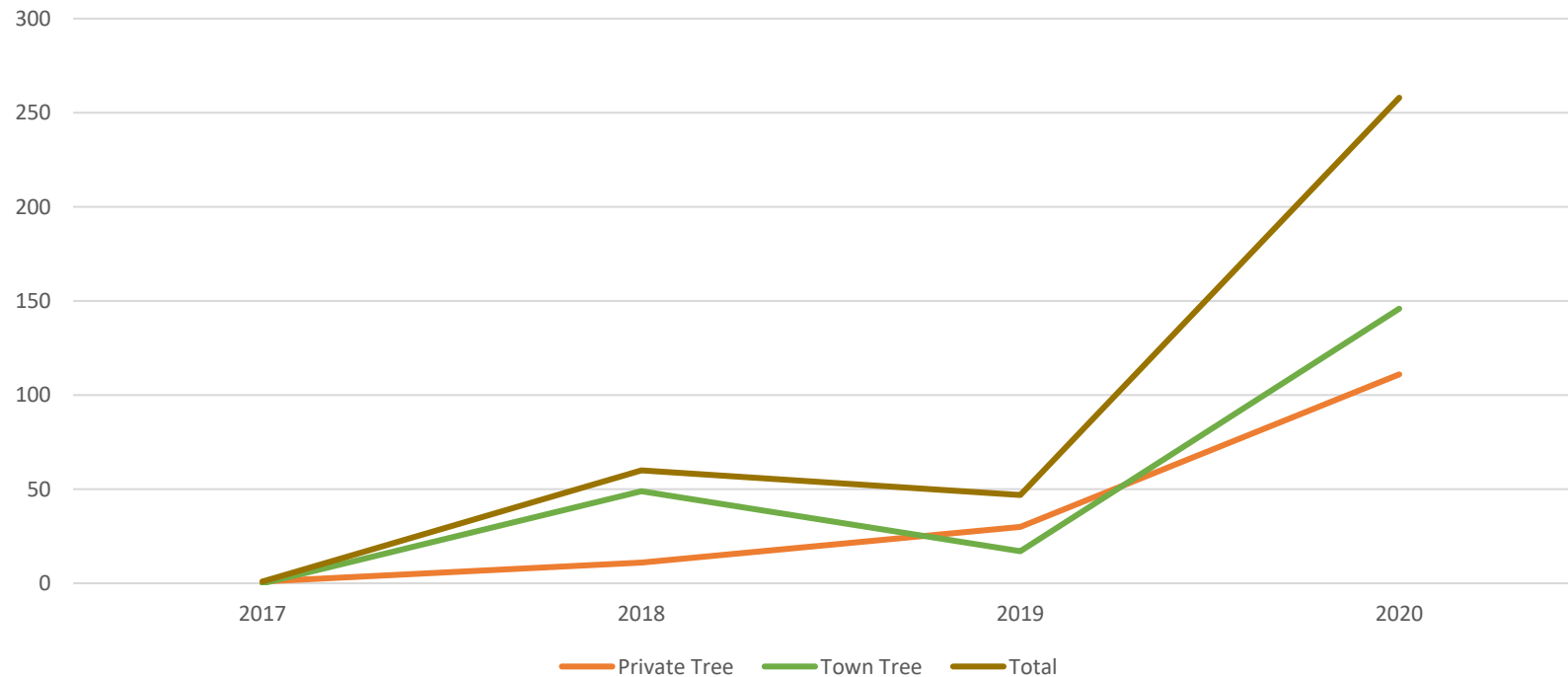

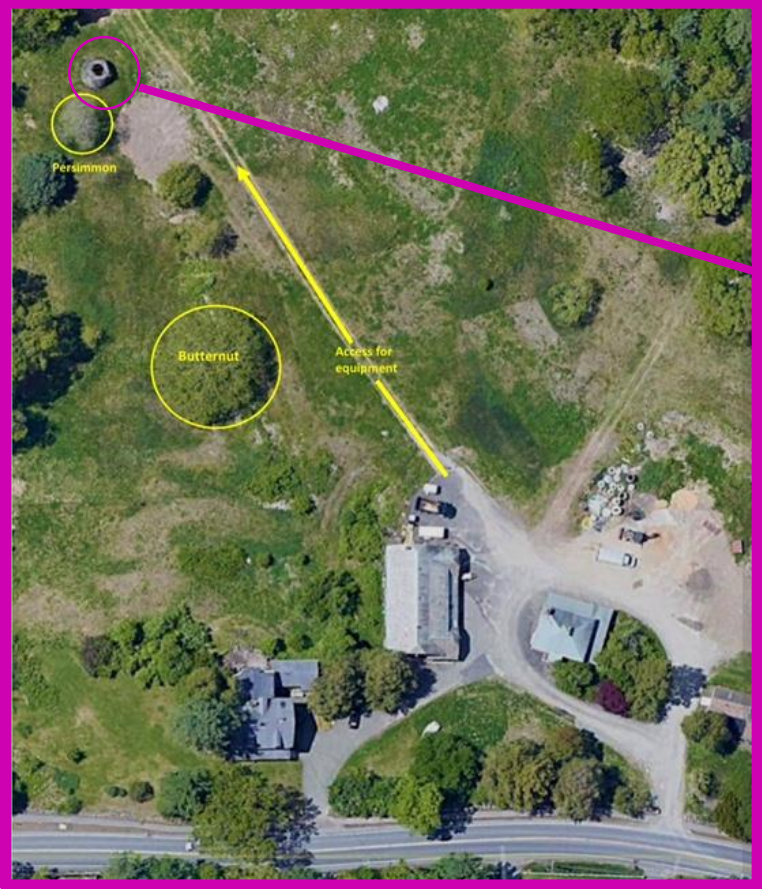

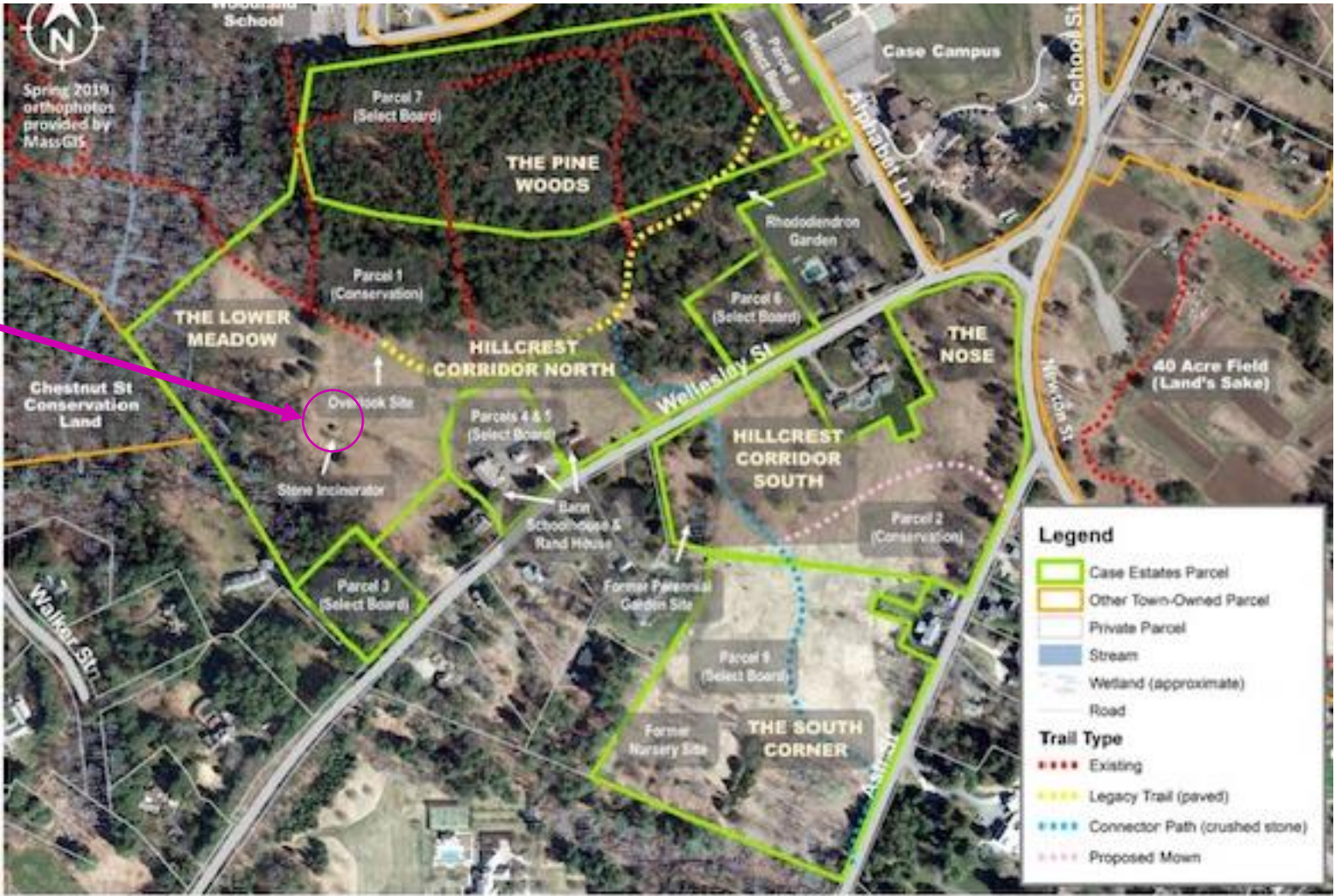
Weston's Emergency Tree Removals 2017-2020



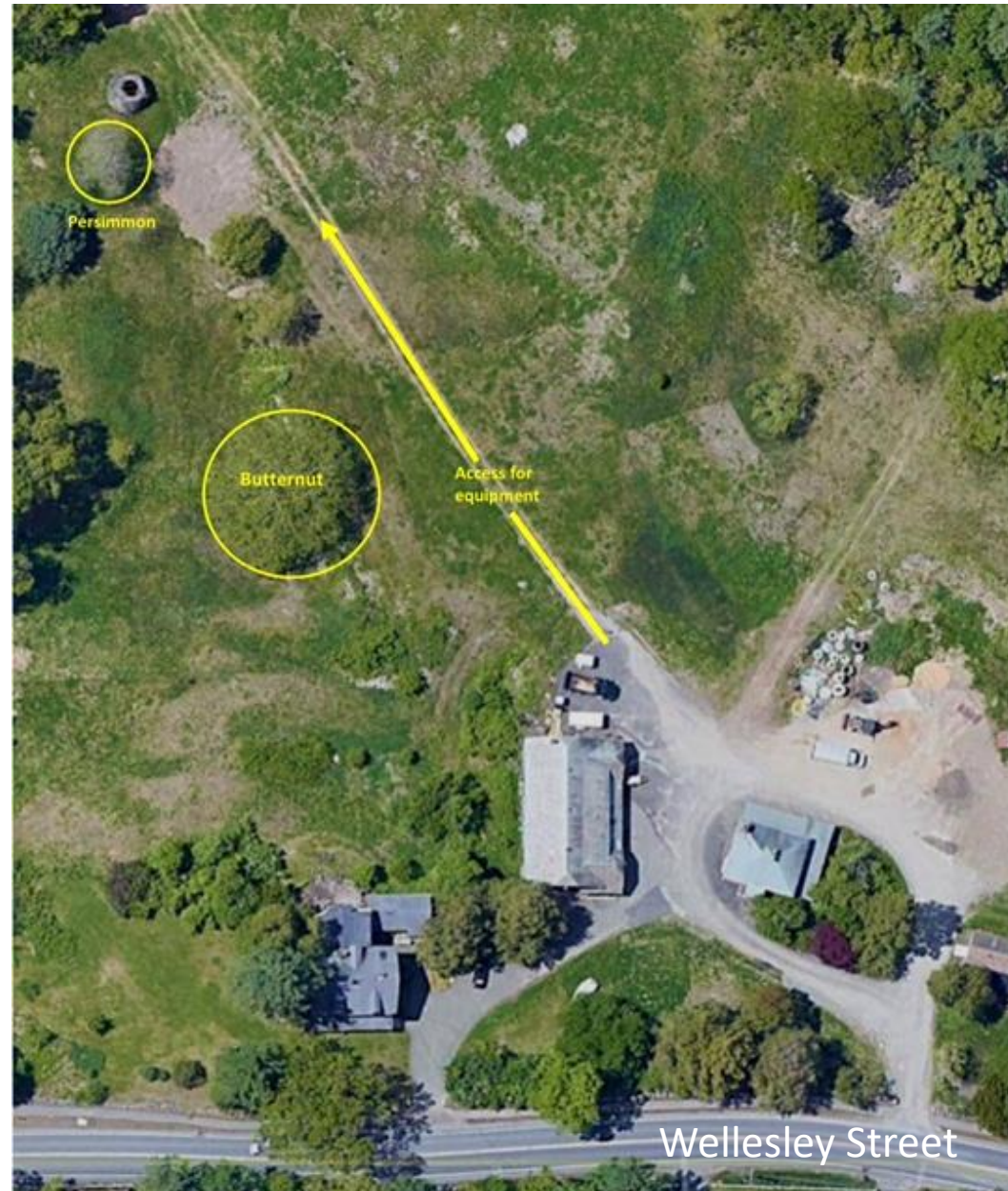
Case Estates Overview Map

but it needs help:

- Invasive vine removal
- Cabling
- Structural pruning
- Dead wood removal

Project Cost: \$3,215

Estimate provided by: Tree Specialist, Inc.

Large Butternut in field:

- crown clean to remove dead/dying/structurally unsound limbs (2" dia and larger)
- reduce heavy ended branches to decrease likelihood of limb shedding in storms
- install (2) cable for supplemental support of weak branch attachments
- cut back any invasive woody plants establishing under tree
- treat cut ends with herbicide to discourage re-sprouting

Persimmon tree nearby with large break in top:

- prune out broken top
- crown clean to remove dead/dying/structurally unsound limbs (2" dia and larger)
- reduce heavy ended branches to decrease likelihood of limb shedding in storms

NOTE: Work requires access to field with equipment - track driven aerial lift device and dump truck/chipper combo **Total: \$3,215**
